This event will also provide opportunities for students to learn accurate pronunciation and to speak in the right tone.

In conclusion, I would suggest the Film Club organize Film Shows, Film Review Writing Workshops and an English Drama Competition to help students to enhance their English language standard. I hope that these can make English learning more fun in our school.
